**SUEZ Energy Generation NA dedicates 746 MW power plant
in Wise County, Texas**

Wise County, Texas – SUEZ Energy Generation NA, Inc., hosted a formal dedication ceremony for its Wise County Power Plant on May 23 at the facility to officially celebrate the plant becoming fully operational and an integral part of the Dallas-Fort Worth area's power supply. SUEZ Energy Generation NA is a wholly owned subsidiary of SUEZ Energy North America, Inc.

The natural gas-fired power station can produce up to 746 MW of electricity depending on ambient temperatures and is SUEZ Energy North America's latest addition to its fleet of energy-producing facilities and the company's second power plant in the greater Dallas-Fort Worth area. The company already has a 343 MW natural gas-fired Texas power plant located in Ennis.

"We are very proud to be here today to help serve the electricity needs of the great state of Texas. The fact that we are gathered here today to inaugurate this impressive facility is testimony to the collective vision and commitment of many people, including leaders at the state and local level, who saw what we saw – a need for a new, clean source of reliable and low-cost electricity that would benefit consumers while contributing to the region's economic viability," said Bill Utt, president and CEO of SUEZ Energy North America.

The Wise County Power Plant generates enough electricity to supply the needs of 800,000 homes and businesses using clean-burning natural gas, most of which is produced locally. During construction, more than 270 contractors were employed on the project. Approximately 30 SUEZ Energy North America employees currently operate the Wise County power facility. Together with the Ennis Power Plant and its headquarters in Houston, SUEZ Energy North America has more than 400 employees based in Texas.

Since becoming fully operational last summer, the Wise County Power Plant has operated at a level of 98 percent reliability and 95 percent availability, making it one of the most efficient and cost-effective power generating units in Texas.

SUEZ Energy North America is part of SUEZ Energy International, a division of SUEZ (NYSE: SZE), which is an international industrial and services Group which employs 160,700 people worldwide and achieved revenues of €40.7 billion in 2004.

About SUEZ Energy North America, Inc.

SUEZ Energy North America, Inc., (formerly known as Tractebel North America, Inc.) is responsible for managing SUEZ' positions within the energy value chain in the U.S., Mexico and Canada, including electricity generation and cogeneration, natural gas and liquefied natural gas (LNG), asset-based trading and origination, and retail energy sales and related services to Commercial and Industrial customers.

SUEZ Energy North America owns and/or operates a total of 44 power, cogeneration, steam, and chilled-water facilities, including those in construction or development, representing a capacity of more than 5,558 MW of electricity generation, 9 million pounds per hour of steam, and 101,000 tons per hour of chilled water. SUEZ Energy North America's wholly owned subsidiary, Distrigas of Massachusetts, owns and operates a liquefied natural gas receiving terminal in Everett, Massachusetts, which commenced operations in 1971 and currently serves most of the gas utilities in New England and key power producers, meeting approximately 20 percent of New England's annual gas demand.

In Mexico, SUEZ Energy North America affiliates operate three natural gas distribution companies as well as cogeneration plants in Tampico and Monterrey, which produce 280 MW of power.
